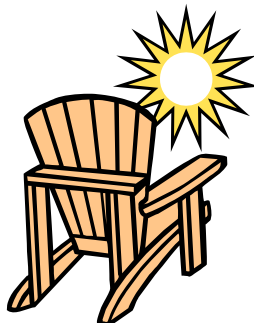
Commodore Comments

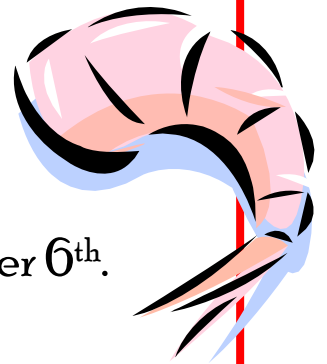
